

TEXLA



Red-skinned potato, late season ripening. Round in shape. Mediocre cooking type.
Completely resistant to late blight. Not suitable for heavy clay soil and fertilizer is not necessary.
Excellent storage potato.

Morphological characteristics

- Plant** medium to tall and intermediate type foliage structure; stems semi-upright and none or very weak anthocyanin colouration; large, light to medium green leaves and closed to intermediate silhouette; low to medium frequency of flowers, medium anthocyanin colouration inner side flower corolla.
- Tubers** round-oval; red-skinned; fairly yellow flesh; moderately deep eyes.
- Sprouts** medium to large, conical, medium intensity of anthocyanin colouration and weak pubescence of base; medium terminal bud with weak to medium anthocyanin colouration of tip; few to medium root tips.
